Chemical Engineering (Course 10) Degree Chart (<http://catalog.mit.edu/degree-charts/chemical-engineering-course-10>): Corrected subject 10.26 to reflect its CI-M designation.

Undergraduate Grading Options (<http://catalog.mit.edu/mit/undergraduate-education/academic-research-options/grading>): Added section for new experimental grading policy to increase flexibility for major exploration in the first year (fall 2018 entrants only).

Brain and Cognitive Sciences (Course 9) Degree Chart (<http://catalog.mit.edu/degree-charts/brain-cognitive-sciences-course-9>): Corrected the number of HASS GIR subjects that can be satisfied by subjects in the Departmental Program from three to two. New statement: "Humanities, Arts, and Social Sciences (HASS) Requirement [two subjects can be satisfied by 9.00 and one other HASS subject in the Departmental Program]; at least two of these subjects must be designated as communication-intensive (CI-H) to fulfill the Communication Requirement."
